



2011 APAGE International SILS Workshop with Hands-on Animal Lab Experience Report

Dr. Yi-xuan Lee

It's very lucky for me to have the opportunity to participate the APAGE International SILS Workshop with Hands-on Animal Lab which held in Shanghai this year. For a beginner of traditional laparoscopic surgery, it's quite a big challenge to participate the workshop for single port laparoscopic surgery. However, having the opportunity to be the operator on my own is still very exciting.

The Workshop was held in the CCI's training center, which located in Hongqiao, Shanghai. The whole building is located in a science park of which the entire place is dedicated for laparoscopic training and animal lab with excellent facilities. The schedule of workshop had two half-day lecture sessions given from South Korea, Thailand, mainland China, and Taiwan endoscopic specialists to share their experiences on single port surgery. And the rest half day was animal lab course. Each two persons were grouped as a team to do the hysterectomy of a pig.

This is the first time I had saw and practiced single port surgery. As an inexperienced beginner, every time I saw the target clearly over there I just couldn't reach it with my forceps. The same thing happened when I tried to make suture. It took me about half an hour to suture only one stitch, which made me and my partner very frustrated! However, it was really wonderful that we have the chance practice it on our own. The struggles we experienced were a must task for our path to be a skilled operator. Furthermore, we were lucky to have tutors giving instructions during hands-on session. I have learned a lot in the two day-long workshop. Laparoscopic surgery is technique-requiring and really needs unceasing practice to be able to be skilled. Hope I can join the workshop like this kind often for practice and be better polished.

On the other hand, many seniors' experiences were shared in the workshop and I felt much inspired when listening to their speech and their achievement. It surprised me how single port surgery has become a new trend and the advanced skills of the faculty. With the lectures along with hands-on practice, we received valuable knowledge and experience shared by the faculty. Although I am just a beginner, I am much inspired with the 1.5 day learning journey.

During our residentship, we had been occupied by the clinical loading with repeated work. Sometimes I feel losing my way and forgetting my goal. This time I felt refreshed and found my way again. The greatest gain I have during this trip is to regain my original passion with a new impetus after the experience this time.

International Fellowship Endoscopy Training Program at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital in Taiwan

Endoscopic surgery has gradually become popular and powerful in gynecological practice, all gynecologist should accept and learn the surgical technique.

International training and certificate is one of the main aims of the APAGE. For quality control, these training centers must fit criterion set up by the Training Committee of APAGE. The APAGE international fellowship endoscopy training program at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital in Taiwan is flexible course and meets various needs of the international fellows. Moreover, there is not only suitable basic training program for those new endoscopists, but there is advanced training program for the experienced gynecologists with the purpose of professional subspecialty training. The most attractive element of the training program is the hands-on part, but hands-on will be unavailable for the short-term fellowship (less than 3 months).


The advanced training program is designed for the sub-special field, especially for the oncologists now. In fact, beside the post-operative recovery and the shorter hospital stay, the laparoscopic oncology surgery has significant lower morbidity rate and shorter operation time by the well trained surgeon than the open oncology surgery. It is the most suitable surgery for the doctors interested in academic research and choose endoscopy surgery as their main career in the future. Generally, duration of endoscopy training program for Gynecological Oncologist fellow-in-training is one year.

International fellowship training is free at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, we also afford free accommodation in your training term.

To Apply for the International Fellowship Training Program, you must prepare formal documentations which we need to submit to our Government Health Bureau department, and it'll take for at least 3 months to complete the application.

After fellows finish the training program, the APAGE will give two certificates, one from Chang Gung Memorial Hospital and the other one is from the APAGE.

The Emergence of The Asia-Pacific Association for Gynecologic Endoscopy and Minimally Invasive Therapy

n 2000, a group of doctors in the Asia-Pacific region, who were dedicated to the endoscopic surgery and teaching, commenced recognizing that there are AAGL in the U.S. and ESGE in the Europe, but there were no society in Asia-Pacific region offering opportunities for doctors to share their research ideas and contribute their knowledge to this field. Therefore, Prof. Chyi-Long Lee, Prof. Yasuyoshi Hayashi, Prof. C.Y. Liu, Prof. Pong Mo Yuen, Prof. Joo-Hyun Nam, Prof. Hiroshi Hoshiai, and Prof. Prashant Mangeshikar decided to establish an association for gynecologic endoscopy, which is officially named "The Asia-Pacific Association for Gynecologic Endoscopy and Minimally Invasive Therapy (APAGE)." As soon as this association was founded, the first APAGE Annual Congress was held in 2004; in this significant day, Prof. Chyi-Long Lee was nominated as the first president and the chair of the board of trustees of the APAGE. Moreover, the constitutions and the bylaws were legislated, so were the guidelines and the basic policy of the association.

We also founded various training committee to meet different needs in the field, since we realized the importance of education. For example, we have the research committee which endeavors to achieve the new milestone in the research field. To provide a platform for doctors to exchange their academic achievements, we have begun to hold the annual meeting. In 2005, the APAGE Annual Congress in the Chinese University of Hong Kong was held grandly by Prof. Pong Mo Yuen; meanwhile, we determined to cooperate with the Covidien in organizing the laparoscopic training course at the C.C.I. in Shanghai in March every year, presenting more training opportunities to the doctors in the Asia-Pacific region. In 2006, Prof. Felix Wong hosted the Annual Congress in Australia which made the Australian experts gain in-depth insight into the APAGE. The annual congresses were held in many countries in the Asia-Pacific region, for example, 2007 Annual Congress was held in Japan by Prof. Osamu Tsutsumi, 2008 in Korea by Prof. Joo-Hyun Nam, 2009 in Taiwan by Dr. Wu-Chou Lin, and 2010 in Singapore by Dr. Bernard Chern. There are numerous doctors participating in the APAGE Annual Congress every year, and it gives the participants more chances to uncover the code value of the association and motivated them to do more contribution toward the world.




