



Reflection on APAGE 2013 Workshop in AITS, IRCAD, Taiwan

It has been a great pleasure to join this year's APAGE workshop with IRCAD in Taichung, Taiwan. The topic of the workshop was "Advancements in Minimally invasive Surgery - The third dimension in Laparoscopy and the Art of Hysteroscopy". Now, advances in technology has demonstrated its function in increasing visibility for the endoscopist, it is proven by the presence of 3D in Laparoscopy. Apart from that, Hysteroscopy now a days has become a routine procedure in many gynecologic cases, but many gynecologist still lack the experience of performing the diagnostic procedure and also operative procedures. I am very fortunate to gain a lot of experience and exposure from this workshop.

On the first day of workshop, basic hysteroscopy and laparoscopy procedures were introduced during the lectures, which gave us an overview and background knowledge of hysteroscopy and laparoscopy. The hands-on training in the afternoon was exciting and challenging. We were being treated like as if we were in operating theater, with all the standart operating procedure. Many stations were made, to give us a chance to perform the hands-on training, starting from the basic from how to perform office diagnostic hysteroscopy until operative hysteroscopy. After the hysteroscopy session we continued to laparoscopy session. The animals were arranged in supine position under general anesthesia, simulating real laparoscopic operations. We were let to performed all gynecological procedures on the animal lab. With 3D scope, we realize that, "depth" is not a problem anymore for surgeons. By 3D scope, hand-eye coordination will be much more easier to control. Besides of that, thanks to Bexter for theirs innovative hemostatic agent to overcome bleeding. With FLOSEAL and TISSEEL, bleeding can be treated more easier and faster. On the second day of workshop, new updates in hysteroscopy, experiences in 3D laparoscopy and management of complication were introduced in detail to us by the lecture from the expert trainees.

I was fortunate to meet Prof. Christhardt Kohler (Germany) who demonstrate and assisted us the 3D Laparoscopy during the entire session and also Prof. Osama Shawki (Egypt) with his interactive and informative way to introduce and to teach us about Hysteroscopy. On the other hand, I also fortunate to meet Dr. Bao-Liang Lin and Dr. Hiroyuki Kanao, both are expert in minimal invasive surgery from Japan. I also very grateful to learn from Taiwanese experts, they are Prof. Chyi-Long Lee, Dr. Chih-Feng Yen, Dr. Chien-Min Han, Dr. Hsuan Su, Dr. Yi-Jen Chen, Dr Chih-wen Tseng, Dr. Kuan-Hao Tsui, and Dr. Pei-Ju Wu. All of them are brilliant instructors with much patience, who guided us through each procedure step by step.

I would like to thank APAGE and STORZ for giving me this wonderful experience workshop. I am also grateful to Dr. Chyi-Long Lee for inviting me to join the workshop. For the first time I was given the opportunity to perform Hysteroscopy and 3D Laparoscopy. I am sure this experience will be of great importance to my future gynecologic surgeries.

From Basic to Advanced: APAGE International Endoscopy Training Program at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital

Endoscopic surgery has gradually become popular and powerful in gynecological practice, all gynecologist should learn the surgical technique.

International training and certificate is one of the main aims of the APAGE. For quality control, these training centers must fit criterions set up by the Training Committee of APAGE. Chang Gung Memorial Hospital is one of certified training centers.

The APAGE international endoscopy fellowship training program at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital in Taiwan is flexible, and course can meet various needs of the international fellows. Moreover, there is not only basic training program for new endoscopists, but also advanced training program for the experienced gynecologists with the purpose of endoscopy subspecialty training.

During fellowship training, international fellows can observe all the procedures of endoscopy surgery, including office hysteroscopy, operative hysteroscopy, laparoscopic hysterectomy, ovarian surgery, single port surgery, NOTES, laparoscopic oncology surgery, infertility surgery, female urology surgery and fetoscopy.

The most attractive element of the training program is step by step teaching according to the learning curve, especially for long term training program. The advanced training program is designed for the Gynecology Endoscopy Specialist. It is the best training program for the doctors interested in academic research and choose endoscopy surgery as their main career in the future. Generally, duration of endoscopy training program for Gynecology Endoscopy Specialist fellow-in-training is one year.







Training is free at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital. We also provide free accommodation during training term. To apply for the International Fellowship Training Program, you must prepare formal documentations which we need to submit to the Health Bureau Department of our Government; and it'll take for at least 4 months to complete the application. After finishing the one-year training program, you can have two certificates, one from Chang Gung Memorial Hospital and the other one from the APAGE.

- English Health report (done in working place and within 90 days of the training starting date).
- * The application process usually takes 3 to 4 months to complete.

All applicants need to specify their preferred starting date of the training course and confirm the duration of training course with us
